WHY DOESN'T SHE JUST LEAVE ALREADY?

A few nights at a Shelter is helpful for a few days, but what happens afterwards? Due to lack of money, abused women are left with few choices, risk homelessness or return to the abusive home.

Abusers intentionally limit their victims access to marital finances. They want their wives to be under their control & very far from independence. After divorce, most abusers are financially unscathed while their wives & children end up living in Poverty.

With consistent long-term experienced Advocacy women systematically build their own economic stability, education & careers. At Dream Bigger we help put these crucial pieces in place, so survivors won't be forced to return to violent homes. We work along-side women through the legal process securing finances & protection orders. We provide hands-on help through Social Services for income & child support then we move on to the educational scholarship & fafsa educational grant process.


Dream Bigger advocates partner with Doris & Warren Buffett's WISP Program for additional educational financial support.

Child Abuse often begins in the Womb. Abusers assault their wives as early as pregnancy. Violence increases the likelihood of PTSD, depression, anxiety & poor selfesteem for the mother and the baby. Children who witness or stay in the atmosphere of physical, mental or psychological abuse are at a higher risk of lifelong mental & emotional struggles. A girl who grows up in a home where her father abuses her

Mother is more likely to marry an abuser. A boy who sees his mother being abused is more likely to imitate the abuse in adulthood. The sooner the mother receives skilled advocacy, the sooner healing & life-rebuilding begins.

Is My Friend Being Abused?

Does her partner keep track of her time? Discourage relationships with friends/family? Prevent her from going to work or school? Criticize her or say Cruel things to her? Humiliate her in in private or in front of others? Destroy her personal property or that of her children? Has she been Pushed, shoved, thrown, kicked, hit, slapped, scratched, spit on, choked or raped? Does she spend a lot of time trying not to make him angry? What Can You Do to Help?

Be supportive. Listen patiently. Allow her to talk, ask her how these things made her feel. It's a big step for her to trust you enough to share her situation with you. Believe her, you could save her life. Let her know it's ok to feel angry or sad. Help her obtain copies of books in audio or print, "Why Does He Do That?" By Lundy Bancroft. If you read it also it could help you to understand. Encourage her to join a local inperson domestic violence support group, offer to take her there each week & help her stay faithful to group attendance.
